

ST. LOUIS AREA FOODBANK QUICK FACTS



The St. Louis Area Foodbank is the region's largest nonprofit food distribution center dedicated to feeding those in need.

1 in 6 people in the bi-state region are in need of food assistance.



392,000

According to the 2014 Hunger in America study, more than 392,000 people rely upon the St. Louis Area Foodbank for help each year.

The St. Louis Area Foodbank distributes food to over 500 area food pantries, soup kitchens, shelters and other feeding programs throughout 26 area counties (14 in MO/ 12 in IL).





At 31%, children make up the largest segment of individuals receiving food assistance from the Foodbank.

The St. Louis Area Foodbank distributed 42.4 million pounds of food in the past year, which equates to more than 34 million meals for our neighbors in need.
