Mary Jane holds master's degrees in speech and theater as well as radio/television from Indiana University and is working towards a doctorate in those fields. From weatherperson to news anchor, from entertainment reporter to producer, Mary Jane has covered all aspects of radio and television at stations from Indianapolis to Sacramento. Local basketball fans will recognize her from frequent a cappella renditions of the national anthem at the Arco Arena, and she is also the official voice of the California State Fair. Her column in the Sacramento Union appears weekly and she can be heard twice a week on radio station KSFM giving the "inside scoop" on Sacramento.

**KITTY O'NEAL** (*Mrs. Squires*) is currently the entertainment reporter for KFBK AM 1530 and the morning drive news anchor on KGBY 92 FM. Now in her sixth year at KFBK/KGBY, she also hosts and produces a weekly public affairs show "River City Sunday." Kitty has hosted numerous radio talk shows including the Morton Downey, Jr. and Rush Limbaugh programs. On television, she has hosted "Open House" on KRBK Channel 31 and "Home Tours" on KXTV Channel 10 and currently does entertainment reports every Thursday evening during the 5 O'clock News on KOVR Channel 13. An accomplished singer, Kitty toured throughout California, Nevada and Oregon as lead vocalist with a pop rock band, and she continues to write songs and perform at special events. Active in the community, Kitty hosts and participates in many charitable fashion shows, auctions, award ceremonies and other events. She is married to a locally celebrated chef, Kurt Spataro.
