THIS WEEK'S CONTEST

UConnreturns home to Pratt and Whitney Stadium to face Rhode Island at noon on Saturday, Sept. 15. Saturday's game is being televised on SNY with Eamon McAnaney (PxP), Andy Gresh (Analyst) and Justine Ward (sidelines).

UCONN VS. RHODE ISLAND HISTORY

The longest series in Connecticut football history, the Huskies' rivalry with Rhode Island dates back to 1897 (the second year of Connecticut football) and Saturday's game will be the 96th meeting in the series.. Overall, UConn leads the series 51-35-8. The Huskies' 51 wins against the Rams are the most that UConn has collected against any single opponent, followed by its 40 wins against Maine and 34 against Massachusetts. The series was fairly even through 1985 but the Huskies have won 13 of the last 17 meetings, including a 1996 Rhode Island forfeit.

The game will be the third UConn-URI game at Rentschler Field as the Huskies posted a 52-7 win vs. the Rams on August 31, 2006 in the season-opener. That game was the collegiate debut for Husky tailback Donald Brown with 118 yards and two touchdowns. Brown would go on to be an All-American in 2008. UConn had 418 yards of rushing in that game, the highest by a UConn team in the FBS era (since 2002).

The Huskies and Rams most recently played in 2009, a 52-10 win for the Huskies in their 1000th game played as a program. Quarterback Cody Endres set career-highs in completions (23) and passing yards (289) and passed for two touchdowns.

Andre Dixon and Jordan Todman combined to rush for 168 yards and Todman scored three touchdowns.

HUSKIES VS. NON-CONFERENCE FOES SINCE 2002

Connecticut boasts a 51-38 record against non-conference opponents in the regular season since making the move to the FBS in 2002. UConn has posted the following records in non-conference regular season games: 6-6 (2002), 9-3 (2003), 4-1 (2004), 3-1 (2005), 3-2 (2006), 4-1 (2007), 4-1 (2008), 4-1 (2009), 3-2 (2010), 2-3 (2011), 3-2 (2012), 0-4 (2013), 1-3 (2014), 2-2 (2015). 2-2 (2016), 1-3 (2017), and 0-1 (2018).

UCONN VS. THE FCS

UConn has played one Football Championship Subdivision school in each season since joining the Football Bowl Subdivision in 2002. UConn is 15-1 overall agains FCS opponents. UConn logged victories against: Florida Atlantic (2002), Lehigh (2003), Murray State (2004), Liberty (2005), Rhode Island (2006), Maine (2007) and Hofstra (2008), Rhode Island (2009), Texas Southern (2010), Fordham (2011), UMass (2012), Stony Brook (2014), Villanova in 2015, Maine (2016), Holy Cross (2017). The lone UConn loss came to Towson in 2013.

THE 2018 SEASON

UConn opens its 120th season of football competition in 2018. UConn first fielded a team in 1896 and played on the gridiron each year except for 1917, 1918 and 1943. The Huskies played as a member of the Yankee Conference from 1947 until 1999, when it was known as Atlantic 10 Football. UConn, an independent from 2000-03, joined the Big East Conference in 2004 and began play in the American Athletic Conference in 2013.

total tackles and a 12.0 tackles per game average through two games. This past week against Boise State, Coyle set a career-high with 14 tackles in the contest. He is tied for 14th in the country in total tackles.

FIVE FRESHMEN, AND ZERO UPPERCLASSMEN, START ON DEFENSE

When the Huskies traveled to Boise to take on the No. 20/19 Broncos on September 9, five true freshmen started on defense for the first time since the program moved to FBS in 2002. Jonathan Pace (DE), Travis Jones (DT), Lwal Uguak (DE), Kevon Jones (LB) and Ryan Carroll (CB) made up the starting contingent of true freshmen and were joined as starters on defense by two redshirt freshmen (DE Caleb Thomas, LB/DB Ian Swenson). The starting defense was rounded out by two sophomores (LB Darrian Beavers, S Omar Fortt) and two redshirt sophomores (CB Tahj Herring-Wilson, S Tyler Coyle).

NORTH OF THE BORDER

The Huskies feature five players from Canada on the 2018 roster. Terrance Ganyi, Hergy Mayala, Phillippe Okounam, Michael Tarbutt and Lwal Uguak all hail from north of the border.

Previous Huskies that represented the country include Martin Bedard(Laval, Que.), Moe Petrus (St. Laurent, Que.), Alex Mateas (Ottawa, Ont.) and Jesse Joseph (Laval, Que.).

FRESHMEN ORIENTATION

The Huskies are not shying away from playing first year players. The Huskies' season-opening two-deep featured 11 first-year players (true and redshirt freshmen) on defense and six on offense. An additional three players on the special teams unit are also first year players.

The week-two depth chart features five true freshmen defenders on the top-line. Additionally, 11 first-year players (freshmen or r-freshmen) are included in this week's depth chart on the defensive side of the ball.

UConn played 11 true freshmen on opening night with eight playing on the defensive side of the ball. Here is where UConn ranks nationally:

PEART NOMINATED FOR WUERFFEL TROPHY

Redshirt junior offensive lineman Matt Peart was announced to the 2018 Wuerffel Trophy Watch List with 105 other players from college football's Football Bowl Subdivision.

The Wuerffel Trophy, known as "College Football's Premier Award for Community Service," is presented annually at the All Sports Association's Awards Banquet in Fort Walton Beach. Named after 1996 Heisman Trophy winning quarterback Danny Wuerffel from the University of Florida, the Wuerffel Trophy is awarded to the FBS player that best combines exemplary community service with athletic and academic achievement.

Peart has started all 12 games the past two seasons for the Huskies and has been a part of football team's leadership council the past two seasons.

CROZIER UP FOR RIMINGTON TROPHY

University of Connecticut redshirt senior Ryan Crozier (Plantation, Fla.) has been named to the 2018 Rimington Trophy Watch List. The Rimington Trophy is presented annually to the most outstanding center in the country.

Crozier played 10 games on the offensive line as a true freshman in 2014 – starting the final three games at left guard. He was moved to the center position in the spring of 2015 but missed all but one game due to injury that season.

Crozier started at center in all 12 games for UConn in 2016 and started last season at the position but was injured three games into 2017. Crozier has been named to the Rimington Trophy Spring Watch list the past three years.

HUSKIES FROM FAR AND WIDE

The 2018 Huskies span all over the country and the world with the team represented by 18 states, Washington D.C. and four countries outside the United States. UConn has five players from Canada, Matt Peart from Jamaica, Luke Magliozzi from Australia and Zavier Scott from Germany. To be expected, the state of Connecticut contains the most

THE STADIUM

The Huskies moved into Rentschler Field in East Hartford for the 2003 season and are set to begin its 16th season as the home of UConn football. The stadium officially became known as Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field in 2015.

Located within miles of Interstates 91, 84 and 384, the home of the Huskies lies on 75 acres of land donated to the State of Connecticut from the historic Pratt & Whitney Airfield. The stadium, like the former airfield, was originally named for that company's founder, Frederick Rentschler. The stadium boasts a capacity of 40,000.

UConn has an all-time record of 62-40 at Rentschler Field and a 34-16 mark in non-conference games. UConn has played to 83.2-pct. of capacity all-time there, drawing 3,326,555 fans, or an average of 33,280 per game. UConn set a new all-time single-game attendance record at Rentschler Field on Sept. 21, 2013 against Michigan with a crowd of 42,704. That capacity was achieved with extra bleachers brought in for that game. Against ECU the Huskies had a record-low crowd with an announced attendance of 14,036.


