

Up to \$20,000 ARMED ROBBERY OF A LETTER CARRIER





The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of **up to \$20,000** for information leading to the **Arrest** and **Conviction** of the suspect.

TAKE NO ACTION TO APPREHEND THE SUSPECT YOURSELF

On Saturday, January 19, 2019, at approximately 2:35PM, a USPS letter carrier was robbed of her keys, at gunpoint, on the corner of 296 NW 59th Street, in the Little Haiti neighborhood of the City of Miami.

The suspect is described as a heavy set black male, weighing between 220-250 lbs. The suspect is between 5'6" and 5'7" feet tall. The suspect wore blue jeans, a black hoodie and a bandana covering his mouth. The suspect then fled the scene in a black newer model Chevy Camaro, pictured above, with dark tinted windows and black rims.
