Lane Closures

Beginning May 29, 2019 until at least Tuesday June 4, 2019:

- Two westbound lanes of Clark between 14th Street and 15th Street. Driving will be restricted during this time to one westbound lane and one eastbound lane for all traffic.
- Short term parking for those wishing to visit the St. Louis Blues Shop for St. Louis Blues apparel will be done on Clark west of the parking cutout on the street

Street Closures:

Street Closures will be in effect beginning at 1:00 pm on Friday, May 31, 2019 until at least Tuesday, June 4, 2019:

- Market Street between Tucker & 14th Street
- Chestnut between Tucker & 15th Street
- 13th Street between Pine & Market
- Kauffman Park & Poelker Park

In addition, on all game days beginning two hours before game time, during the game and one hour after the game all lanes of 14th Street between Clark Street and Market Street will be closed.
