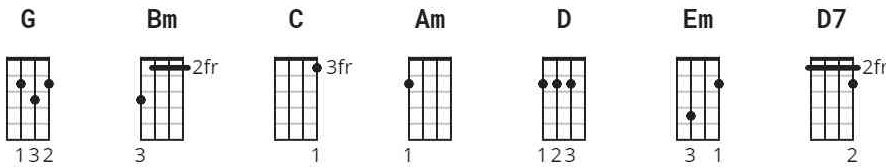


Operator ukulele chords by Jim Croce
