This webinar program will focus on landowners, producers and anyone interested in learning more about enrolling land into CRP through the General Signup.

FSA will accept General Signup CRP applications through February 12, 2021. To apply, producers should contact their local USDA Service Center.

Signed into law in 1985, CRP is one of the largest private-lands conservation programs in the United States. The program marked its [35-year anniversary](#) in December 2020.
