Saturday, July 31st Noon to Midnight

We are so excited about our 6th birthday this Saturday. Not only will it be the best weather in weeks, but we have the beautiful, shaded beer garden, live music, and awesome food to go with it. We are so happy to be here for another year and want to celebrate with all the amazing people who helped us to grow our business over the last six years. We really have the best community of supporters, and we are here because of you!

For the celebration, we will have live music, food, and a variety of beverages. Mahope will be on-site serving awesome Cambodian food from noon until 9 pm. We will have Seanti-Aeris performing during the daytime from 2-5 and Xander Wells will be playing in the evening from 6-9.

Since we will be utilizing both taprooms, we will have 20 of Fibonacci's finest on tap for the event. Some of the special releases are as follows:

- Black Raspberry Trillium: We utilized an award-winning Purple Trillium wine barrel from the local winery [Burnet Ridge](#) and filled it with a sour ale and black raspberries that we grew and harvested.
- Mulberry Grove Sour Ale: We partnered with our neighbors in Mount Healthy to harvest locally grown mulberries from our own neighborhood to add to this special once-a-year sour ale.
- Persica Hoy: We used peaches grown from [Lobenstein Farm](#) to put into our Belgian Tripel which is always a birthday favorite!
- Maillard Maple Cinnamon: We used bourbon barrels from [New Riff](#) to make this pastry stout. We have a few other variations to share throughout the day and evening.
- Covalent is our newest American Strong Ale with an ABV of 9.9%
