
# **RMB 1-Year Anniversary Weekend**

# Ten Different Greater Cincinnati Oktoberfest Celebrations to Enjoy German Beer, Brats and Bands

One of the best things about living in a city with such a rich German heritage is that Oktoberfest season is taken very seriously. And while we have a giant Oktoberfest Zinzinnati celebration downtown each year — the largest in America — plenty of other breweries, neighborhoods and organizations are hosting their own events so you can Prosit and party all month long. Here are 10 different Oktoberfests being held across the city where you can don your dirndl and fill your stein.

#### West Side Brewing Oktoberfest, Sept. 10-12

The Kantine food truck will be parked at West Side Brewing all weekend, with Bavarian chef Peter Schuster at the helm, so you can enjoy Oktoberfest chicken and Weisswurst with your beer. In addition to games and fun like giant beer pong and inflatable jousting, there will be live music, stein fills, cornhole and Jenga. Sept. 10-12. #### Covington Oktoberfest, Sept. 10-12

Covington Oktoberfest returns to historic Goebel Park. The celebration will span three days this year and will be free and open to all ages. Visitors can look forward to enjoying live music, local art and food and drink vendors during the festival. The first event took place in 1979 and offered an annual party honoring the community's deep German roots and culture. #### Oktoberfest Zinzinnati, Sept. 16-19

After last year's giant public party was canceled due to the pandemic, organizers are making up for it this year by adding an extra day (with festivities starting on Thursday) and extra hours. "Cincinnati's sister city, Munich, is the original and the world's largest Oktoberfest. As that tradition is not happening in 2021, Oktoberfest Zinzinnati is going to borrow the title of 'Biggest Oktoberfest on the Planet," said Cynthia Oxley, director of Oktoberfest Zinzinnati, in a release. "With an extra night of reveling and extended hours each evening, the party is going to be even bigger." 5 p.m.-midnight Sept. 16; 11 a.m.-midnight Sept. 17 and 18; and 11 a.m.-9 p.m. Sept. 19. Free. # Loveland Oktoberfest, Sept. 24-25

# Donauschwaben Oktoberfest, Oct. 1-3

Cincinnati's German Donauschwaben Society hosts what they refer to as the "most authentic" Oktoberfest in town. The fest offers more than 30 different beers on draft, including German favorites, along with pitroasted pig and chicken; homemade sausage; stuffed cabbage; spatzle; pastries; goetta; and plenty of other tasty German treats. There will also be a "Trachten Parade" on Saturday afternoon, with participants donning traditional costumes, as well as dancing performances and a log-sawing contest.
