## Election Integrity: The S.A.F.E. Way to Vote

Reform California has proposed a ballot measure to require voter ID in California for all future elections. Until that is law, we urge you to secure your vote using this S.A.F.E method:

**SEND:** Mail in your vote on Day 1 of the election. Do NOT wait until Election Day as the county has cut back on polling locations and long lines will suppress the vote. Voting on Day 1 also gives you the full 30 days of the election to fix problems and verify your vote is counted!

**AUDIT:** Track and verify your ballot was 1) received and 2) counted online at [www.SDVOTE.com](http://www.SDVOTE.com). Check every few days until your vote is verified.

**FIX:** If your vote is not shown as received and counted by day 20 of the election, go to the nearest Polling Center near you and demand a second “provisional” ballot and vote in-person. Do NOT wait until Election Day.

**EXAMINE:** Sign up as a volunteer with our Election Integrity team to monitor the counting of ballots.
