

# Northside burger restaurant Tickle Pickle opens second location inside of craft brewery Listermann

A Northside burger joint just opened its second restaurant location inside of a Cincinnati craft brewery.

Tickle Pickle, which first opened on Hamilton Avenue in Northside in 2015, opened its second location inside of Listermann Brewing Co. at 1621 Dana Ave. in Evanston on Nov. 28.

Tickle Pickle offers a menu of piled-high hamburgers, with a robust vegan offering. Menu items include:

- Breadzepplin, a cheeseburger with American cheese, mayonnaise, ketchup, lettuce, tomato, onion, and pickle
- Meatallica, with mayonnaise, American cheese, bacon and egg, with goetta available (and recommended) as an addition
- Rob Zomwich, with cheddar, spicy ketchup, hot sauce, a jalapeno popper, grilled peppers and onions and banana peppers on a pretzel bun
- Buns N Roses, a black bean burger on a vegan bun with spicy ketchup, lettuce, tomato, onion, and pickle
- When Buns Cry, an Impossible meatless burger with spinach, caramelized onion, tomato, and balsamic dressing

Listermann Brewing started out as a homebrew supply store in 1991 before becoming a production brewery in 2008. Tickle Pickle will operate during its taproom hours (noon to 9 p.m. Sunday through Thursday, staying open an hour later until 10 p.m. on Friday and Saturday) and offer delivery through DoorDash.

The partnership to bring Tickle Pickle inside of the brewery came after Listermann made the decision to close its freestanding restaurant, the Listermann Brewing Trail House, nearby at 3701 Montgomery Road. That August closure stemmed from the pressures facing the entire restaurant industry, including a staffing crunch, rising ingredient costs and the lingering effects of the Covid-19 pandemic.

We didn't talk a lot about it last year, but when the Streetside team brewed up Socially Influenced last year, a little bit of it was tucked away in a bourbon barrel... just to see what would happen. Lucky for us, things turned out great... and they're ready to release it for all of us to enjoy together!

The brewery is throwing a big event this year for the winter solstice and not only will Barrel-Aged Socially Influenced be hitting taps (and cans) but there are going to be three different, big barrel-aged beers released that day. It's going to be a celebration of not just the big "social" community, but of winter drinking in general.

It is all happening at the <u>Streetside taproom on 12/21 from 4-10 pm</u> – which... brings up another point that I know someone will point out. It might be a little chilly outside. Not only will these big barrel-aged beers warm you up from the inside, but Streetside is going to have a bour<u>bon barrel fire</u> on the patio for you to hang out around, too.
