Voodoo Brewing plans brewpub in Cincinnati and now in the suburb of West Chester

A Pennsylvania-based craft brewery is expanding nationwide and appears to be eyeing an additional Greater Cincinnati location in the suburbs. Voodoo Brewing Co. is targeting a property at 9456 Water Front Drive in West Chester Township after building and sign permits were submitted to Butler County officials. This would be the brewery's third location in Ohio, with one in Cleveland and <u>another slated to open at 120 E. Eighth St. in downtown</u>

The West Chester location has yet to gain approval from Butler County. According to the building permit, the project would cost \$250,000. It would add to a plethora of retail shops, restaurants and entertainment destinations in this part of the Cincinnati suburb, including AMC Theatres and Top Golf.

The location would be owned by a franchisee, according to multiple officials connected to the project, meaning it would be independently owned and operated. The local franchisee did not respond to a request for comment as of this posting. Other Voodoo Brewing locations serve food – like pizza, burgers and nachos – in addition to beer.

The news comes after Voodoo Brewing revealed last year its ambitions to embark on a nationwide expansion. The company selected commercial real estate services and investment firm CBRE as its exclusive leasing agent.

"Craft breweries is a sector that has recently taken off," said <u>Patricia AmecAngelo</u>, first vice president for CBRE, in a statement from last year. "Voodoo boasts strong unit economics coupled with healthy returns to franchisee operators."

Voodoo Brewing, according to a CBRE news release, seeks out 4,000 to 7,000 square feet of endcap or stand-alone space within 10 miles of 25,000 households. Each location typically provides indoor seating for 75 to 150 people, it added.

Voodoo Brewing is expected to do any on-site brewing at its downtown Cincinnati location. It's unclear if that will also be the case in West Chester. Most of its products will be shipped from its Pennsylvania headquarters to Cleveland, where the store will distribute the beer southbound.

Founded in 2005, according to CBRE, Voodoo Brewing has received national and international accolades for its beers, food and logo artwork. In addition to locations in Pennsylvania and Ohio, its website says, the brewery has locations in Nevada, Colorado, and South Carolina.
