
Taft's Ale House Closing



We are very deeply saddened to announce the upcoming closure of Taft's Ale House. We've made the painfully difficult decision to close our beautiful flagship location after 8 years of serving the OTR community. Our final day of operation will be Saturday, November 25, 2023.

The pandemic, a significant decline in tourism, and large increases in material goods costs have contributed greatly, but ultimately, we could not indemnify for the significant loss in sales since Covid began. We have self-sustained daily operations for the past couple of years, and it's clear our business model is unable to financially support the location in this new landscape.

Our main concern right now is our Ale House team's future. At the core of Taft's Ale House has always been our incredible staff. Their hard work, commitment and cheer brought to the Ale House and OTR will be greatly missed. We've given everyone notice of the closure and will pay severance to each individual employee. We're offering employment opportunities wherever we have them, at our Brewpourium locations and contract beverage business. Additionally, we've compiled local hospitality job openings that have been shared. If you know of a favorite local bar or restaurant that is hiring, please share with us. We'd love to refer our talented team members, who, in our opinion, really are the best in the city.

Taft's Brewpourium Cincinnati and Columbus will continue to operate as normal. We want to wholeheartedly thank our loyal patrons, friends, OTR and the city of Cincinnati for all the love and support over the years. Prior to our closing, please stop in and enjoy a pint with us.

Drink and Get Inked at Rhinegeist's Annual Beer and Tattoo Celebration

INKED, Rhinegeist's annual celebration consisting of plenty of beer and tattoos, returns to its Over-the-Rhine taproom this week. Happening on Saturday, Nov. 18 from noon to 9 p.m., INKED features unique variants of Rhinegeist's imperial stout, Ink, on draft, along with some of Cincinnati's premier tattoo artists doing live tattoos of pre-selected flash art in the taproom all day. "As fall arrives, we are excited for the upcoming annual celebration of Beer and Tattoos here on Elm Street," Karen Bear, AGM at the Rhinegeist taproom, said in a press release. "We are excited to welcome back some existing shops to the taproom, as well as some new artists, bringing us up to seven shops for this fourth iteration of INKED!"

Participating tattoo shops include: White Whale, Black Fern, Lonesome Town, Decorated Body, Got Ink? Mothers, and Peregrine. Each parlor will have its own booth and a flash sheet of tattoos available to purchase that day. Tattoos will be on a first-come-first-serve basis, so patrons are encouraged to arrive early to secure a spot with their preferred artist.

INKED will also have a pop-up bottle shop featuring vintage brews from the Rhinegeist Barrel Aged portfolio, and The Empanadas Box will be on-site selling food. Rhinegeist will also be selling 16-oz. cans of Ink and Cherry Cordial Ink, a limited-edition Ink variant canned especially for this event. Both beverages' designs showcase hand-drawn flash art by the Rhinegeist team. There will also be limited-edition collectible Ink merch, like the new 2023 T-shirt design and koozie, for sale.

Rhinegeist CEO Adam Bankovich on Business Courier podcast

Craft breweries can grow in a number of ways. For one, they can produce more beer, send it to more retailers and open up distribution to new markets. But another way they grow is by increasing their physical footprint, opening taprooms in other cities and sometimes in different neighborhoods. That's a tactic some of the region's largest breweries have employed as of late. <u>MadTree just announced its third brick-and-mortar location</u> in Blue Ash, <u>Braxton Brewing is opening its fourth</u> in a development alongside Dewey's Pizza and Graeter's Ice Cream and <u>Fifty West will anchor the District at Deerfield</u> development.

Cincinnati's largest craft brewery, Rhinegeist Brewery, has only had one brick-and-mortar location in Overthe-Rhine where the public can visit and drink its beer. But that's something new CEO <u>Adam Bankovich</u>, <u>who took the role full-time in October</u> after serving as interim chief executive since April, is thinking about changing. "It's really fun to entertain the idea of a new taproom location that we've never done," he said on "Above the Fold," the podcast by the *Cincinnati Business Courier*.

"That idea's been floated around for a few years, but we're about to get really serious about considering it. But I don't have a specific answer to give you on what that would look like. Other than, the most important thing to me is maintaining that authenticity, the Rhinegeist experience." Bankovich said he doesn't want to move too slowly, but also wants to be methodical about the decision. "We're absolutely considering it and trying to be methodical and understanding, OK, if we're going to do this, how are we going to do it our way, how do we do it the right way, how do we do it in a way that resonates and adds something to whatever community we go to and not just standing up a box that serves draft beer in a community we think we might be able to do it."

Bankovich also talked about how Rhinegeist has been able to maintain growth despite the flattening of the craft brewing industry, what's new at the brewery (hint: <u>a fan-favorite brew is coming back next year</u>) and how he maintains the unique culture as the OTR brewery's new leader.


