

Catch-a-Fire Pizza closing inside MadTree Brewing Oakley, brewery plans new restaurant

Catch-a-Fire Pizza is closing its restaurant inside of MadTree Brewing's Oakley taproom, but the brewery has its own plans for that space. Catch-a-Fire Pizza and MadTree issued a joint release Dec. 5 announcing the pizzeria will discontinue operations inside of the brewery's Oakley flagship on Jan. 1, 2024. The relationship between the two stems back to 2013 – when both entities opened, Catch-a-Fire parked its food truck at MadTree's original location on Kennedy Avenue. Since that time, though, Catch-a-Fire has expanded with new locations in Blue Ash and Lebanon, and MadTree has opened its own restaurant inside MadTree Alcove in Over-the-Rhine. According to the news release, MadTree decided not to renew Catch-a-Fire's lease and will open its own restaurant inside the Oakley taproom.

"Catch-a-Fire has been a great partner over the last decade. We've cherished working with them since the early days at our original location," MadTree co-founder Kenny McNutt said in the release. "We wish them all the best in the future and much success as they move forward with their other locations and catering business."

A MadTree spokesperson said in an email the brewery will begin renovating the kitchen on Jan. 1, 2024. Pizza will remain a mainstay at the brewery, along with an expanded menu of sandwiches, appetizers, kidfriendly items, and seasonal offerings. The kitchen will be closed during the renovation with a target reopening date of early spring 2024.

During the closure, MadTree will offer service from a rotating roster of food trucks, including Red Sesame and Sweets & Meats BBQ. Food truck service will be provided seven days a week during taproom operating hours. Catch-a-Fire Pizza in the release said it plans to open additional locations in the Cincinnati market but did not disclose what those plans are. The pizzeria also plans to offer mobile catering in 2024, bringing its wood-fired pizzas to private events.
