**To Stratford:** Take Hwy 17 North to HWY 175 West to Stratford. Parking available behind the COOP.

**To Van Wall Equipment:** Take R21 South out of Stratford towards Boone to E18 East to Story City, North into Story City on HWY 69. Van Wall is on west end of town.

**To Sts Peter & Paul:** Hwy 69 South to Gilbert, thru Gilbert, North on 500<sup>th</sup> Ave

## **TUESDAY**

**To Eagles Ledge Madrid:** Take Hwy 30 East to County Road R38 (Slater) and Hwy 210 West to Madrid

**To North Polk HS Alleman :** Hwy 210 East to Hwy 69 South to Alleman

**To Woodward:** NW 158<sup>th</sup> Ave thru Polk City across the Saylorville Bridge and HWY 141 up to Woodward.
