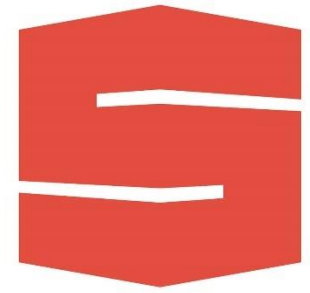

The Gnarly Gnome Brings Back Cincy Beer Week

Cincinnati, Ohio—The Gnarly Gnome, one of Cincinnati's dedicated beer bloggers and supporters of the local beer community, is bringing back Cincy Beer Week, a tradition that this city hasn't seen since 2017. From October 4th through October 13th, 2024, events all across the greater Cincinnati region will draw beer drinkers together to celebrate more than just the fizzy beverage that gives the week its name.

Cincy Beer Week is being built from the ground up to celebrate community, education, entertainment, and everything that has enabled our beer scene to grow in the last few decades, from less than a handful of breweries to more than 70 today.

Craft beer diehards and curious newcomers alike will find events ranging from beer tapplings and festivals to educational experiences that help them become better beer drinkers. These events will take place in venues all across the city (free of charge to the venue), from Craft Brewery taprooms to local neighborhood bars and everything in between.

The Gnarly Gnome says this about why beer week is important - "I'm a sucker for a great beer, make no mistake about that, but what makes me keep working my butt off to support the beer scene in Cincinnati is the other pieces around the drink itself. The people, the places, and the experiences that make up Cincy Beer are second to none in this country - and it's time we start getting a little louder about that."

About The Gnarly Gnome— With a beer blog (TheGnarlyGnome.com) and a podcast (CincyBrewcast.com) both spanning a decade, plus an active YouTube channel and social media presence dedicated to drinking in Cincinnati, The Gnome has defined what it means to "Be Gnarly" about Cincinnati Beer.
