Streetside, Brink, Wandering Monsters win GABF 2024 medals

Cincinnati is bringing home more hardware, as <u>Streetside</u>, <u>Brink</u>, and <u>Wandering Monsters</u> all picked up GABF 2024 medals.

Great American Beer Festival takes place in Denver annually, and breweries from the Queen City are no stranger to winning at the event.

Streetside Brewery, located in Columbia Tusculum, won a gold medal in the English-style Brown Ale category for Black Cats. It's the first GABF medal for Streetside, but not the first medal for Black Cats. The same beer also won a silver medal at the World Beer Cup in 2023 and a silver medal at the US Open Beer Championship earlier this year. It also won a gold medal at the Ohio Craft Brewer's Cup last year. It's now one of the few beers that has medaled at all three major craft beer competitions.

Brink Brewing Co, located in College Hill, continues their amazing streak of winning at GABF every year, as they took home a bronze medal in the Sweet Stout or Cream Stout category for Moozie. Moozie is one of the most awarded beers in Cincinnati, as this is the fifth GABF medal for that beer alone. It's also won a World Beer Cup medal and multiple US Open medals. Brink now has 11 GABF medals and won the Very Small Brewery of the Year in back-to-back years in 2018 and 2019.

Wandering Monsters Brewing has been open for just over a year in Anderson, but they're already putting their name on the map with a GABF medal after winning four at the US Open earlier this year. They won a bronze medal for Triple Chocolate Viator Obscura in the Chocolate Beer category. It's the first GABF medal for brewer Zach Boehnke.

New OTR brewery offering Blink-themed sneak peek before formal opening next month



A new brewery slated for Over-the-Rhine is offering a preview to patrons during the city's biennial Blink light festival, which is expected to attract record crowds in 2024. Mellotone Beer Project, a concept founded by Dennis Kramer-Wine, formerly of Rhinegeist Brewery, and Alexandra Nowell, the first brewmaster to helm Los Angeles-based Three Weavers, is opening its doors to the public for the first time Thursday, Oct. 17, for a sneak peek of the space and in celebration of Blink, a massive display of art and light that spans the region's urban <u>core</u>. Mellotone will host "Arcade of Light," an interactive art installation by Cincinnati-based Kemper Sauce Studios throughout the duration of the show, scheduled for Oct. 17-20. The Courier first announced plans for the brewery in August. Mellotone replaces Taft's Ale House, which shuttered in November 2023 after an eight-year run. The 12,345-square-foot, three-story space, a former condemned church building at 1429 Race St., is owned by Cincinnati Center City Development Corp. (3CDC). "Blink is such a distinctive Cincinnati event, we couldn't pass up the opportunity to be part of it," Nowell said in a media release. "This is a chance for everyone to stop by, check out our new space before it 'officially' opens and enjoy a few drinks while they venture through the neighborhood." Once fully operational, Mellotone will serve up two concepts under one roof: The lower level of the space will house a neighborhood bar called Undertone. It will feature midcentury modern design elements along with a small stage for live music. The main floor will house Mellotone's restaurant, highlighted by modern American fare, and the mezzanine will be transformed into an indoor beer garden with communal seating, "Arcade of Light" has appeared during previous Blink festivals. It features a blend of gaming, art and engineering. Each piece was created to be both fun and approachable, with an exaggerated scale. The installation is designed to include three different retro-style games which utilize LED light panels. Kemper Sauce Studio's "Arcade of Light" was featured at Washington Park during Blink in 2019. Blink 2024 will include more than 80 light projections, light-based installations, murals, activations, live music and performances spanning 30 blocks from Over-the-Rhine to Northern Kentucky. In 2022, the event drew more than 2 million people from 29 states, resulting in \$126 million in direct economic impact for the region.

"The historic church that houses Mellotone is such an iconic OTR space," Lindzie Gunnels, commercial leasing director with 3CDC, said in the release. "It's the perfect spot to host Arcade of Light, and Blink is the ideal opportunity to introduce the neighborhood to this creative new brewery." Mellotone will open from 6 p.m. to midnight during Blink.

Following the festival, Mellotone will close its doors to complete its final renovations. The brewery hopes to celebrate its grand opening in mid-November.




