Notwithstanding that the WUCS signal is not as strong as some other radio signals, I was receiving a listenable WUCS signal on my radio at the above location and I was a regular listener of WUCS from the above location. However, my ability to regularly listen to WUCS at the above location has been disrupted since the WUCS signal is being interfered with by a new FM translator. This FM translator signal is rebroadcasting the signal of station WDAQ HD-3 (97.9 and 107.3 The Bull) and can be heard when I tune into 97.9 at the above location. I wish to continue to regularly listen to WUCS at the above location without being subject to interference caused by the new FM translator. I understand that this statement may be filed with the Federal Communications Commission to protect the WUCS signal.
