## MONDAY

To Martensdale HS: Take 92 West to R63, north on R63 to G24. West on G24 to Hwy 28. Go South on Hwy 28 into M artensdale follow signage into your destination.

To I35 Truro: Take 92 West to I35 south. Exit at the Truro exit and travel into town on Truro Rd to 135 HS

To Talk Shop Lounge: Trace back to I35 and North to St Charles exit. West into Town, Talk Shop Lounge is on the east end of St. Charles.

## TUESDAY

To Runnells Elementary: US Hwy 65/69N to HWY 5 S/US 65 N, take exit 77 to SE Vandalia Road, right on Hwy 316...Runnells Elementary will be on left

To Cordova Park: Hwy 316 North, left on Hwy 163, Exit 29 IA-14, right on IA14, left on Hwy G28, right into Cordova Park \& follow signage.

To Pleasantville: Left on Hwy G28, left on Hwy IA-14 into Knoxville, right on M cKimber to IA-5 N/IA-92 W, follow IA5 N, right on Hwy G40/W Jasper St, left on S West St

## WEDNESDAY:

Lake Ahquabi State Park: East on Hwy 92, right on Hwy 65/69, right on Co Rd G58 and straight into Lake Ahquabi State Park.
